

When did you know you had an ART talent?

As a child in grade school. When teachers and other students make a fuss over what you've created, you begin to realize that you may have a talent.

When did you begin your art education?

You begin self learning at a very young age, but I think the first actual "art" titled class I had was in 7th grade.



Whose art was an inspiration to you and who was an ART mentor to you?

Once I learned about Andrew Wyeth around age 20, I found his works to be the most inspiring for me. As far as mentors go, I had none. I had to figure things out myself. What other art styles do you like to paint in or draw in? Creating with digital art programs. I would also enjoy learning more 3-D software if possible.

Do you have any art book(s) that you have always drawn inspiration from?


Nope.Lastly, do you have a question that you like to ask other artists to get them to open-up and talk about their art?(See question no. 1) Thanks for asking!













